No evidence has been produced in the years which have transpired since the invesitgation into the fencing accounts to show that Brant is not justified in making a claim. The Department is therefore willing to make to settlement to Brant upon the basis of your report. If therefore the Council of the Tyendinaga Band passes a resol tion approving of the claim being settled at \$65.09 the Department will issue a cheque in Brant's favour for that amount, and close out his account.
