Gentlemen,-

In reply to your letter of the 5th instant, asking for specifications of No. 2 quality ties, and particulars of the 250 cords of soft wood which the Indians of Manitoulin, unceded part, propose taking out, I have to state that it is not possible to indicate what may be classed as No. 2, but it includes all not up to the No. 1 standard.

It is assumed that the wood may contain all kinds and that the cord is 128 cubic feet.
