In your return for 1911, you shows the divisions Seton Lake as Nicait, Seton Lake and Mission, while in 197 you gave Schloss No. 5 as one of the divisions instead of Mission. Is this Band known by the name of Mission and a Schloss?

Dog Creak which was shown in your 1910 return w not reported on in 1911, but appears in your 1912 return with a population of 20 Indians.
