I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your several letters of the 5th instant, 8th instant and three of the 12th instant, (your No. 2870050) and have to request you to be good enough to reserve from sale or settlement or other disposition, the lots in the Fort Smith Settlement referred to in your letters, Lots 4, 26, 32, 35 and 39, until we receive a report from our Indian Agent regarding the occupation of these lots and also regarding any other lands that may be required for Indians in that locality. As it is difficult to communicate with Fort Smith during mid-winter, it may be some time before we are able to advise you in this matter.
