In addition, we are utilizing 625,000 persons in war industry, of whom 550,000 are men.

Outside of agriculture, we have, therefore, harnessed to the war effort 912,000 men in the present war.

Thus, in two years, we have exceeded the total man-power effort of four and a half years in the last war.
