With respect to title in severalty, he would recommend that they work title be granted to Indians subject to the condition that they be not allowed to dispose of their properties for a period of 25 years; he thought the lands should be non-allowable to suyune, either whites or Indians, for that period; Otherwise the pethod cycles would soon give bee or three Indians control of all the Lands.

As to relactions of reserves, he presented a table of values as those appeared at the close of the last fiscal year, these values being largely judged by the price of lands contiguous. A fair value only had, he thought, been given to all the reserves. He clas put in evidence his description and valuations of reserves (EXHIBIT JIS) and consum returns, giving population, religious, and all much general statistical information. (EGUERY JA)

gr Commissioner Shore During the Commission's visitations of reserves in your Agency, as youghness, they heard many complaints against yourself personally. If you wish to make any statement in commestion with these matters the Commissioners are prepared to hear its

Agent Halliday thought that it might perhaps be well for him to do so. The Reyal Commission had, somewhat unfortunately for him. come into his Agencyjust as he had completed the prescution of a number of cases under the anti-potisch law, and all the Indians in the Agency appeared to be under the impression that this was a personel matter, and , to use a common expression, were sore at him in consequence. He had been told before the coming of the Commission to the Agency that three of the Indians were making it their special business to go around and organize a compaign for his dismissal from the office of Agent, as they were of the opinion that if he were got out of the way the potlach might have a longer Joyse of life. On another point, Chief Conhagaleese had endd that he and the Agent (wit nous) were strangers to one another and that such a condition should not exist between an Indian Agent and any of his people. The reason that the Agent and Chief Ownhagelesse were strangers in this instance was briefly this: In the Pall of 1900 an Indian committed a rape on a white woman at Alert Boy and was cought in the set by a Provincial
