WINNIPEG MARKET LETTER

Wheat—For the past week May wheat shows a gain of 7¢c, July 8¢c, October 9¢c. The tendency throughout the week has been higher, and there has been a gradual and steady gain without any wide fluctuation. The chief cause of strength is the new crop prospects in the American winter wheat areas and the American and Canadian spring wheat areas. With the lateness of the season and the lack of preparation in most districts, there is sure to be a small acreage seeded this spring, and under present world conditions, last year's surplus will be required to make up the deficit of this year's production.

Oats—May oats gained 1¢c, July oats 1¢c for the week. There was no special feature to the oats market. There was a fair demand for cash oats at the same discounts under May price as prevailed a week ago, except that on Saturday No. 2 Canada Western were 1¢c wider discount.

Barley—Barley showed a slightly stronger tone, with light offerings and not much business done.

Flax—Flax futures were quiet after the break of the previous week, and prices showed a gain of 1¢c on May and 2¢c on July.
