

## CAN PUT A WASHER ON A TAP.

Ald. Lamb is an Expert and is Proud of the fact—Amalgamating the Inspection Departments.

Although Ald. Jolliffe did not have a quorum present at the meeting of the special committee for the amalgamation of the Inspection Departments yesterday, he, Ald. Lamb and Ald. Crawford, contrived to have a lively time among themselves with the assistance of Medical Health Officer Sheard.

Ald. Jolliffe, when speaking on his pet scheme of getting more work out of the inspectors, met with an opponent in the person of the newly installed Medical Health Officer, who stated that if his men were expected to look after the taps, etc., as well as the sanitary condition of the premises they visited he would be unable to keep a direct tally on their movements as he expected to be able to.

The Chairman explained that his scheme was to amalgamate the departments in such a manner as to enforce a house-to-house inspection at least four times per year. The Health Department could have special inspectors for special work.

Ald. Crawford favored this idea, being much anxious to have a house-to-house inspection system inaugurated at once.

Ald. Lamb thought that it would take up too much of the time of a Sanitary Inspector to be attending to taps.

Ald. Crawford (who had come to put a washer on a tap in a couple of minutes) said: "Ald. Lamb: Can you put a washer on a tap?"

Ald. Crawford: No! Can't say I can. It may be necessary to know how to do such things down in cabbage town, but we of the West End can get others to do it for us.

Ald. Lamb: Well, I can fix any tap in my house and I'm proud of it, and I tell you no man can put a washer on a couple of minutes. Why, it would take him a great deal longer than that to get the water turned off.

Ald. Crawford: Well, I think we had better adjourn until we see what action the Board of Health proposes taking.

Ald. Jolliffe: Practically this means that Mr. Sheard is to be in charge of the question in his hands then, and so I propose to ask him what action he intends taking in the matter. Now, doctor, let me know. Are you against my scheme or not?

Dr. Sheard (diplomatically): I will not approve or disapprove of the scheme of the Board of Health. I will deal with all matters affecting my department in my regular report to the Board of Health, which will be submitted to that body in due time.

Ald. Jolliffe: Well, I'm not going to stand this treatment any longer. I'm not going to come here and have Ald. Lamb do nothing but sit there and obstruct every proposition I bring forward. I'm going to throw the scheme up as a bad job.

Ald. Lamb: No! At all, not at all, Ald. Jolliffe. The only reason why I'm not going to vote for your scheme when it comes before council.

The committee adjourned to wait on the action of the Board of Health.

## THE CITY MUST PAY.

But the Amount of the Damage Will Be Settled by Arbitration.

The claim of Fred C. Jarvis against the city for damages to his property was formally recognized by Justice Armour at the Assizes yesterday. The plaintiff owns the old Severn Brewery in Yonge-street in old Yorkville and the \$7000 damages claimed to have been done to the property by the city in laying a sewer across it without the plaintiff's permission. The city's reply was that both the plaintiff and the previous owner had consented that more than six years had passed and that any claim had to be submitted to arbitration. The plaintiff, in reply to this, said that the drain was originally intended for surface water, not sewage; that permission was granted to Yorkville, not to Toronto, and so had lapsed. The amount of damages will be settled later by reference.
