TWENTY or twenty-five years ago the Christian women of the churches of this country as well as of Great Britain were moved by the Spirit of God to undertake the work of enlightening and reclaiming the benighted women of heathen lands. It was one of the most remarkable movements of our time in its depth, its extent, and its moral elevation. It appeared to be so divinely guided as to avoid extravagances, and it worked with the utmost leyalty to the instituted authorities of the Church of Christ.
