Besides the well equipped laboratories and thorough laboratory teaching McGill offers exceptional opportunities for students in the clinical branches having at her disposal the material of the Royal Victoria, Montreal General, Montreal Maternity and Alexandra Hospital for Infectious Diseases.

The Faculty also offers a Post Graduate Course, a course for the Diploma of Public Health, and a course in Dentistry leading to the degree of D.D.S.

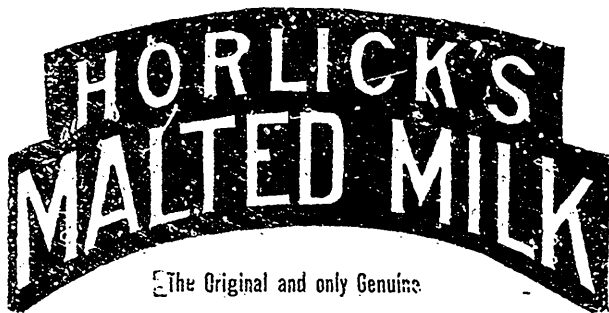
