ACTS OF THE INTERNATIONAL WHALING CONFERENCE

Signed at Washington, December 2, 1946

The Governments of Argentina, Australia, Brazil, Canada, Chile, Denmark, France, Netherlands, New Zealand, Norway, Peru, Union of Soviet Socialist Republics, United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, and the United States of America, represented by plenipotentiary delegations, and the Governments of Iceland, Ireland, Japan, Sweden, and the Union of South Africa, represented by plenipotentiary delegations,

Having accepted the invitation extended to them by the Government of the United States of America to attend an International Whaling Conference;

The Conference met at Washington, D. C., on November 20, 1946, under the Temporary Chairmanship of the Government of the United States of America.

Held in Washington

From November 20 to December 2, 1946

With the approval of the President of the United States of America, Clark A. Whiland, Acting Chief of the Bureau of International Commerce, Department of State of the United States, was designated as Secretary General of the Conference, and Donald J. Chancer, Chief Counsel, Fish and Wildlife Service, Department of the Interior of the United States, was designated Technical Secretary of the Conference.

Pennington Kellogg, Chairman of the Delegation of the United States of America, was elected Permanent Chairman of the Conference at the second session, held on November 28, 1946, and Dr. S. G. Skjeltved, Member of the Delegation of the United States of America, was elected Chairman of the Conference at the same session.

The general constitution, rules of procedure, and other matters were adopted provisionally at the opening session of the Conference by the Temporary Chairman as follows:
