

International Conference

On 4-5 December 1991, the Institute, in collaboration with the Prague Institute of International Relations, convened a conference in the Czech and Slovak Federal Republic on "The CSCE and Future Security in Europe." The conference took the form of five panels and brought together cabinet ministers, senior scholars, politicians, government officials and international journalists.

Television Project

In January 1991, the Institute produced two pilot television programmes on foreign policy decision making using a hypothetical scenario format. The success of these programmes led the Institute to begin discussions with the CBC, Radio-Canada and an independent producer, Cameron Graham, on the possibility of producing a four-part series in both English and French.

Discussions led to an agreement to produce two prime time programmes in English for air on the main network of the CBC, and two programmes in French for air on Radio-Canada. All the parties involved were on the verge of signing a tripartite contract to proceed with production of the programmes when the federal budget announcement put the project on hold.
