Membership

5. Membership of the Group shall be open to all States which are interested in the production or consumption of, or international trade in, copper, and to any intergovernmental organization having responsibilities in respect of the negotiation, conclusion and application of international agreements, in particular commodity agreements.

Powers of the Group

6. (a) The Group shall exercise such powers and take action or arrange for action to be taken as may be necessary to carry out and ensure the application of the provisions of these terms of reference.

(b) The Group shall not have the power, directly or indirectly, to enter into any contract for the purposes of trade in copper or in any other commodity or product, or any contract for future transactions; nor shall it have the power to enter into any financial obligations for such purposes.

(c) The Group shall adopt such rules of procedure as are considered necessary to carry out its functions and which shall be subject to, and not inconsistent with, these terms of reference.

(d) The Group shall not have the power and shall not be taken to have been authorized by its members to incur any obligation outside the scope of these terms of reference or the rules of procedure.

Headquarters

7. The Headquarters of the Group shall be at a location selected by it in the territory of a member State, unless the Group decides otherwise. The Group shall negotiate a Headquarters Agreement with the host Government to be concluded as soon as possible after these terms of reference have entered into force.

Decision-making

8. (a) The highest authority of the Group established under these terms of reference shall be vested in the General Session.

(b) The Group, the Standing Committee referred to in paragraph 9, and such committees and subsidiary bodies as may be established, shall take decisions by consensus and without a vote, except in the case of decisions for which a specific voting majority is specified in these terms of reference or in the rules of procedure.

(c) Each member State shall be entitled to one vote.

Standing Committee

9. (a) The Group shall establish a Standing Committee, which shall consist of those members of the Group which have indicated their desire to participate in its work.
