

Consequently, if the party forming the government before the election wins a
 simple majority or has the largest number of seats in the new House of
 Commons, the members of the Cabinet must be sworn in again. Even
 when a general election returns the same party to power, the
 new Cabinet is usually changed.

Another party with a majority or the largest number of
 seats in the new House of Commons, the Prime Minister within a few
 weeks submits his resignation and that of his Cabinet to the
 new Government. It is a recommendation that the leader of the
 winning party be asked to form a government.

The Prime Minister is the
 head of the Government and
 is responsible to Parliament.

He is the chief executive
 of the Government and
 is responsible for the
 general administration of
 the country.

The Prime Minister is
 elected by the House of
 Commons and is the
 leader of the Government.
