

Mr. MacGuigan, seconded by Mr. Joyal, moved,—That the motion be amended by deleting therefrom all the words after the word “referred” and substituting therefor the following words:

“to a Committee of the Whole House”

Mr. Knowles (Winnipeg North Centre), seconded by Mr. Benjamin, moved in amendment thereto,—That Bill C-59, An Act to provide for the resumption and continuation of longshoring, checking, cargo repairing and related operations at certain ports in the Province of Quebec, be not now read a third time, but that it be referred back to the Committee of the Whole House for the purpose of reconsidering Clauses 5(3), 7, 8, 11(2), 13 and 14 thereof.
