A meeting of Deans was called by the Principal on Thursday at 12. a.m. to give further consideration to the honorary degrees to be awarded at the Graduates' Reunion Convocation.

The Secretary of the Graduates' Society had informed the Principal that the women of the Alumni <sup>at</sup> recommended Professor Carrie Derick, Emeritus Professor; that they were not interested in a degree for General Patterson but were agreeable to a degree for Dr. Harvey Smith; that the President of the Graduates' Society suggested that a degree should be given to the Prime Minister, Right Honorable R.B. Bennett.

The Deans unanimously agreed to recommend an honorary degree for Mr. Bennett; but they refused to sanction one for Miss Derick. They reviewed again the cases of Smith and Patterson and decided to recommend them for the degree.
