CHAPTER IV.

NOTES AND CARDS OF INVITATION.

Invitations should be sent in the name of the lady of the house.

The usual form is simply "Mrs.——requests the pleasure of Mr. and Mrs.——'s company on - - - - " The evening, the date of that evening, and if the party is small the hour, are then inserted.

If the daughters and sons of the family are invited, a separate note is sent to the

The answer should be "Mr. and Mrs. — accept with pleasure Mrs. ——'s invitation for Thursday evening next;" (or whatever evening it may be;) the date of the day in which the answer is written is placed on the left hand, at the bottom of the note.

Misses ——— and another to the Messieurs

If a refusal is sent it should be expressed as follows: "Mr. and Mrs. ———— regret that it will not be in their power to accept Mrs. ———'s invitation for Thursday evening next," the date as before.
