

NOTICE TO POSTMASTERS.

For List of Money Order Offices in Canada, see pages 1 to 10.

The Lists of Money Order Offices in the Lower Provinces will be found on pages 11 and 12; and as there are in the British and the several Lower Provinces' Lists offices having the same names, Postmasters must be exceedingly careful, when they draw upon such offices, to add after the names the initials or full names of the countries in which they are situated, thus, England, Scotland, Ireland, N. B. for New Brunswick, N. S. for Nova Scotia, P. E. I. for Prince Edward Island, and N. F. for Newfoundland.

And as there are in the English, Irish and Scotch Lists names of offices several times repeated, in order that the advices may go to the places intended, the county or shire in which such offices are found must be stated. For instance, in England there are seven Newports, all Money Order Offices, also two in Ireland, and one in Scotland. In Ireland there are two Ballycastles, and Scotland, though it has no names duplicated within itself, has names which appear on several other lists. To obviate the possibility of errors from repetitions of names, the Money Order Offices should carefully specify the offices drawn on.
