## ADMIRAL JELICOE ARRIVES IN CITY

## Hero of Many Campaigns Met by Toronto Navy Veterans.

## A SPLENDID RECORD Escapes Drowning in Camperdown to Lead Britain's Fleets.

Quite unassuming and informal, with only a squad of policemen and a guard of 30 naval veterans under W. R. Field, to welcome him to Toronto, Admiral Sir John Jellicoe and Lady Jellicoe arrived at the Union Station from Ottawa at 7.45 o'clock on Saturday morning. A reception had been originally planned for the noted visitors, but for some reason was not carried out.

All the blinds of the special coach were down when the train pulled in and the news soon circulated that the admiral was still sleeping, and would not leave the car until 9.30. As the train pulled in, a group of railwaymen, who had gathered at the foot of Bay street, burst into a cheer, which was acknowledged by the Admiral and Lady Jellicoe.

The admiral, who celebrated his 60th birthday on Friday, is small of build and wears an undress naval uniform, with the white and gold epaulettes denoting the rank of an admiral. Her ladyship wears a sea-skin coat and black velvet hat.

Before leaving the station the admiral, accompanied by Lady Jellicoe, passed through the lower entrance of the station, where they were saluted by the guard of honor, composed of men who saw service in the war. Each of the two ranks of honor won during the war and were members of the Naval Veterans Association, passing along the line, Admiral Jellicoe shook hands with each man in the guard and cheered them heartily with them about their war service. Lady Jellicoe also displayed a keen interest in the men and carried on conversation with several of them.

The members of the guard were the members of the guard who were of praise upon every man's lips as they passed. The admiral was warmly welcomed by George Beardsmore, 138 Beverly street.

With the Admiral and Lady Jellicoe were Capt. H. Share, Flag-Lieut. L. Morgan, Admiral Kingsmill and Sir Joseph Pope.

Soon after the arrival of the admiral, the guard of honor, consisting of 30 blue-jackets and veterans of the Canadian Navy League, drawn up in the square entrance, were dismissed and the admiral and his party, with the Inspector Mackie, with the exception of a few guarding the car on the siding at Bay street, dispersed after a brief conference.

While perfectly willing to converse with anybody, Admiral Jellicoe could not be induced to make any important statements and declared himself not in a position to talk as he had to make a report to the Canadian government.

At noon a civic reception committee, including representatives of the Naval League and led by Commodore Jarvis waited upon the admiral at the residence of Mr. George Beardsmore, 138 Beverly street.

The reception committee included: Hon. E. C. Drury, premier of Ontario; Mr. T. L. Church, mayor of Toronto; Mr. John C. Eaton, Commodore Amielus Jarvis, Mr. E. P. Brown, president of the Canadian Navy League; Mr. A. Stapell, president of the Empire Club; Mr. H. C. Stanton, president of the Rotary Club; Mr. T. B. James, president of the Ontario committee of the R.C.Y.C., and reception committee of the Navy League, as follows: Messrs. Goffrey, Craig, Macdonald, and Mr. John Brown, P. F. Brintnell; also Mrs. John Brown, Dominion president of I.O.D.E., and

Admiral Jellicoe will be tendered a civic public reception at the council chamber at the city hall on Monday afternoon at 2 o'clock. The reception will be at 3 p.m. and will be presided over by Mayor Church. Members of the Ontario cabinet, the city council, and a board of education, the separate school board, harbor board, board of trade and other bodies have been invited.

The admiral is to be present on Sunday at 11 o'clock at the Association memorial meeting to Earl Cardwell, fallen hero in Oakwood Theatre.

Sir John's Record.
