the Enemy.

St. Petersburg, March 2.—In a lexo-  
pical to the czar, Viceroy Alex-  
says:

"Admiral Stark, telegraphing from  
Port Arthur to-day, March 2, states  
that no enemy did not appear off Port Arthur  
on Feb. 23, Feb. 29 or March 1.  
Reconnoissances made by cruisers and  
torpedo boats over a radius of sixty  
miles from Port Arthur also failed to  
discover the enemy's vessels."

Major-General PRUG, Viceroy  
Alexieff's chief of staff, sends in the  
following telegram dated March 2:

"According to additional information  
which has reached me, our patrols hav-  
ing passed the enemy's mine belts (seventy  
eight miles) from Pingyang, approach-  
ed that town on the morning of Feb. 29.  
They were only closely pressed by a
