I regret very much that I have not made these transactions clear in former statements. In future I will endeavour to show on each receipt and Receiver General Payment just what the amount of money shown is intended to cover. I am enclosing a statement showing the transactions under Permits No.27 and 30 referred to in your letter.

I might say that these two permits originally cost me several days work in the bush and elsewhere running down what timber had been cut and to whom sold.
