Little Schooner Put U-Boat To Flight

French Government Pays Honor to Gallant Boatswain and Crew

Paris, Oct. 3.—The minister of marine has commended in navy orders the French sailing vessel Kleber, of 277 tons, which, on September 7, stood up to a big German submarine off a single south of Brittany and placed a single gun so well that her opponent retreated discomfited after three hours of stirring battle.

Pierre Monet, the boatswain, who fought the ship after the captain of the Kleber was killed, has been decorated with the Legion of Honor, while the twelve men of the crew, several of whom were wounded, have been given war crosses. Several members of the crew who particularly distinguished themselves received the military medal in addition to the war cross.
