FRONTENAC BREWERY DOUBLES IN PRICE; 10,000 SHARES

MONTREAL EXCHANGE AGHAST AT SUDDEN DEVELOPMEN

Issue Closed Last Night at 60; Opens Today Stmr. Prince Arthur. 923, McKinnon, from Roston at 120-National Breweries Also Is Active

MONTREAL, Aug. 13-With over 10,000 shares changing hands in the early trading and the price jumping 60 points overnight to exactly double its closing quotation, Frontenac Breweries staggered market followers when the local stock exchange opened this morning. The last sales of Frontenac occurred at 60. Today the first sales were recorded at 120. National Breweries followed Frontenac's spectacular performance with nearly a 5,000 share turnover, and a price advance of 4 1-8 to 54.

The balance of the list was very quiet in comparison, but a firm tendency was in evidence. Montreal Power was in some demand and rose ½ to 206. Consolidated Smelters was another strong spot, selling ¾ higher at 114¾, while Ogilvie advanced 1 in light trading to 165. The balance of the list was quiet.
