The slogan "Shop more from 10 to 4 and you'll avoid the crowds," is to be used in newspaper advertising, car and show window posters and in other forms of publicity.

Advantages of the 10 to 4 shopping pointed out are these: More passengers can get seats on street cars if they shop during these "off-peak" hours; clerks in stores can serve customers better if trading is scattered through the day. Electric Railway Association conven
