"Liquor export houses in this province are allowed to ship consignments of liquor to Alberta and the United States in defiance of the prohibition laws of these countries.

"What becomes of the liquor that shipped? Some is shipped to Alberta. Some is shipped to the States.

"Calculations show that bootleggers in this province handle as much liquor as the government stores. Where do they get it from?

"Why is it that liquor shipments are allowed to purchase liquor openly in this province from export houses to ship to other provinces and states in defiance of their laws?

"Why is it that law enforcement officers of these provinces and states are not advised of these shipments by the agents of the Liquor Control Board?

"The attorney-general's own partner is among the successful counsel who appear for the defence of bootleggers.

"It is time to stop fooling with a theories turn a blind eye to the operation of the 'export' houses. It is time to enforce the law in the interests of law and order.

"This subject is of Dominion-wide interest. It is very clear that bootlegging thrives better under government sale laws than under Prohibition laws.

"The Anti-Prohibitionists must devise some better plan than government control for handling the liquor traffic, before our Canadian citizens will vote against Prohibition laws.
