KEEP IN MIND POSSIBILITY  
OF HOLY WAR IN TURKEY  
English Delegates in Paris Urging That  
Sultan be Allowed to Remain in Con-  
stantinople

Paris, May 20.—(By the Associated  
Press.)—The English delegates are urging  
that the Sultan be allowed to remain in  
Constantinople and are anxious that the  
United States accept the position as  
mandatory of that city, as well as Ar-  
menia.

THE danger of a holy war is influencing  
the council, which has been advised that  
radical changes are inadvisable without  
more foreign troops at strategic points to  
steady the situation.  
The inter-Allied commission desig-  
nated to investigate the Asia Minor  
situation is still in Paris.

MORE TROOPS COMING  
The Caronia, which sailed last Wed-  
nesday for Halifax carries the 18th, 19th,  
20th and 21st battalions with General  
Bennie and staff, a total of 106 officers  
and 5,666 other ranks.

The Boheiman has sailed for Quebec  
with nineteen officers and 187 men  
from Kinnel Camp. The Granplan also  
for Quebec, carries twenty-six officers,  
three nurses, forty-one warrant officers,  
292 men from Buxton, 428 wives, 171  
children and forty-three babies.
