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

THE AMUSEMENT TAX

The announcement of the amusement tax order passed by the lieutenant-governor-in-council, which is made by the provincial tax inspector in another part of this issue, is interesting, inasmuch as it affords very necessary information to all of those who are anxious to observe whatever laws and regulations are passed in connection with the collection of the amusement tax. This small contribution from patrons of amusements has, apparently, not met with much, if any, objection wherever it has been imposed. In Ontario, the addition to the revenue of the province amounted last year to nearly a million dollars and in other provinces of the dominion the revenues were increased very consdeirably indeed. were increased very consdeirably indeed by this form of taxation, which placed no great burden upon anybody.


