

We re-roofed the big barn - using Bradford roofing over the old shingles (to save cost of scaffolding) and painted it with tar. Patched other roofs - entirely overhauled shingles on Institution roof. Repaired lavestroughing - and had new laves for laundry - also a new copper.

Had all plaster repaired - that in girls play room was worst.

Built new outside stair case from senior school - new railings and platform and steps from junior school - these were patched last year when other outside steps were built.

The three furnaces were overhauled and pipes cleaned.

One car of furnace coal was received.

One acre of irrigation completed.

The paint work was all cleaned during the holidays - windows washed - floors and furniture cleaned so no time was lost when school opened.

Allowing children holidays is now altogether a blessing - so many return in dirty condition - we have to use quantities of antiseptics and send more clothing to laundry than is ordinarily necessary. If we had proper bathing facilities - this trouble would be sooner overcome.
