COMMERCIAL COURSE.

The object of the catholic commercial Academy of Montreal, the re-opening of which will take place on the 4th September, is to impart to young men intending to engage in business, a complete knowledge of commercial transactions, so as to enable any one of them, after having followed the entire commercial course, at his entrance in a merchant's office, to be familiar with all the business transactions of each office, viz: banking, discount, exchange, purchase, sale, insurance, &c., &c.

To obtain this result, the instructions of the commercial course comprise: calligraphy, the French and English languages, commercial geography, history of commerce, arithmetic, book-keeping, exchange, foreign currency, commercial correspondence, commercial law, study of merchantable goods.

Drawing, vocal music, stenography form also part of the instruction of this course.

The following branches of study are optional and are taught by special professors.

Telegraphy and instrumental music (piano and violin.)

The most efficient means employed in the commercial schools of Europe are in use in this Academy.

The transactions of the business class are, as far as possible, the same as in a regular office: collection of samples of productions, raw and manufactured, informations on the most frequent adulterations. All, in short, concurs to justify the title of the establishment: **Commercial Academy.**

On the second of october next, the business class will be opened in the evening from 7½ o'clock to 9½ o'clock, for young men engaged in business or whose occupations will not allow them to attend during the day. Diplomas will be delivered to such pupils, attending the evening course, as shall have undergone a satisfactory examination.
