QUINZE MILLIONS DE CATHOLIQUES

DANS L'AMPIRE BRITANNIQUE

Londres, 17.—D'après le Catholic Directory 1927 et le Catholic Who's who 1927, il y a actuellement en Grande-Bretagne 30 archevêques et évêques catholiques, 4,742 prêtres catholiques, 2,517 chapelles ou chapelles. L'Empire britannique a en Europe (Angleterre, Ecosse, Irlande, Gibraltar, Chypre, Malte), 6,137,066 catholiques, en Asie 3,669,954. Ce qui donne pour tout l'Empire britannique un total de 15,289,660 catholiques sur 435,000,000 d'habitants. La population catholique du monde entier est estimée à 334,664,791.

Le Catholic Directory donne en outre chaque année des listes complètes de diocèses, vicariats et paroisses apostoliques de l'Empire britannique, la liste des archevêques et évêques, de tous les prêtres séculiers et réguliers des congrégations religieuses, etc.

Quand au Catholic Who's who, il donne actuellement des biographies de toutes les personnalités catholiques anglaises.

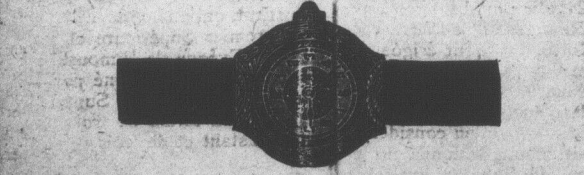
LE PROGRES DU CATHOLICISME

EN ANGLETERRE

Londres, 17.—L'Angleterre est le pays où il y a le plus de conversation au catholicisme. Dans le seul archidiocèse de Westminster, 1,727 protestants se sont convertis au catholicisme. Dans les autres archidiocèses, les conversions catholiques se recrutent principalement dans les milieux intellectuels. Beaucoup tiennent une place en vue dans la littérature anglaise contemporaine. Il suffit de citer les noms des romanciers Newman, Benson, Stead, Chesterton, Belloc, John Galsworthy, Wilfrid Ward, Baring, MacKenzie, Tyran, Father Ronald Knox. L'Angleterre compte aussi de nombreux poètes catholiques: Charles Thomas, Alice Meynell, De Vere, Father Faber, Gerard Hopkins, John Banister, John Galsworthy, Lionel Johnson qui sont déjà morts, et Chesterton, Wilfrid Childe, Padraic Colum, Shane Leslie, Viola, Oliva et Francis Meynell qui vivent encore.

Le dramaturge L. Housmann est catholique. Parmi ceux qui se consacrent à l'histoire et à la biographie, Lingard, Gasquet, Bede Camm Martindale sont également catholiques. Ces écrivains sont des convertis.
