NOTICE TO RETURNED SOLDIERS

By order-in-Council, dated Oct. 16, 1915, no ex-members of the Canadian naval or military forces shall be entitled to the benefits of re-training under the Department of Soldiers' Civil Re-education Act, until they have completed a course of re-training in made within three months from the 1st day of November, 1918, provided that where an ex-member of the Forces is discharged by any ex-member of the Department of Naval or Military Forces is subsequent to the 1st November, 1919, provided that where an ex-member of the Forces has been discharged by any ex-member of the Department of Militia and Defence or the Department of Soldiers' Civil Re-education, the Department of Soldiers' Civil Re-education shall be entitled to a continuation of treatment such ex-members of the Forces as have completed three months from the date of their return to Canada from the completion of such treatment in which to make application for the benefits of such re-training.

Applications for such re-training of ex-members eligible in New Brunswick, should be addressed to: "District Vice-Consul, New Brunswick, at one of the following addresses: (1) at St. John's nearest to home of applicant, (2) at the Heriot Hospital, Fredericton, N. 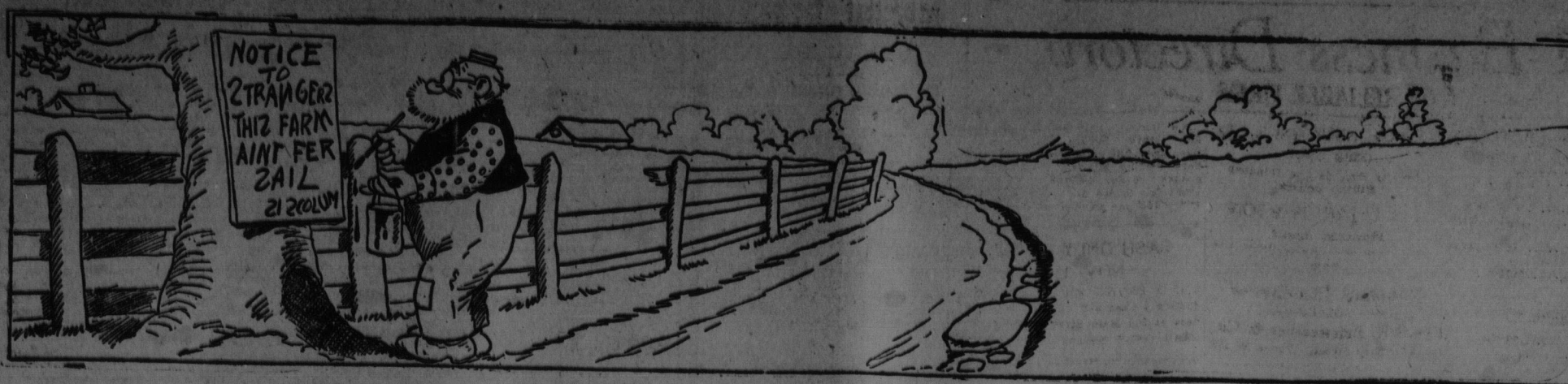
