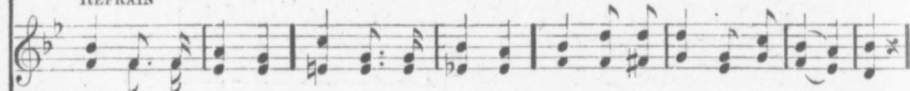
Yes, oh, yes! be good and true, Pa - tient, kind in all you do:

For the joy - ful work and true That a lit - tle child may do;



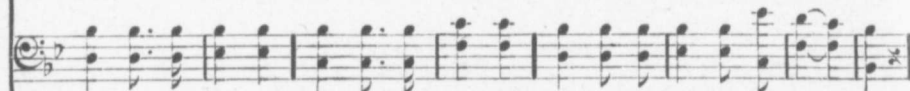
Love the Lord, and do your part; Learn to say with all your heart:
