

Temporary organization of a local branch of the "Hadassah," a Jewish women's organization to provide medical relief for stricken Palestine, was affected yesterday as the result of the visit to the city of Mrs. Joseph selick of Toronto.

The Hadassah is a non-political

rganization, its membership comprised of women, and identified with the Zionist movement for the purpose of procuring and transporting medical supplies, and providing institutions, nurses and doctors for the relief of the Hebrews of Pales-Canada in which the Hadassah has been organized, and already flourish-ing branches are established in To-


