HAGAR, PETER. (Prescott.)

Ancestors emigrated from England to Massachusetts before the American Revolution. S. of Abner Hagar, J.P., merchant, Montreal, who settled in Plantagenet, Ont., 1820, by Hannah P. Barker, of St. Johnsbury, Vermont, B. in Plantagenet, 1827. Ed. at Peacham Academy, Vt. Unmarried. A farmer, merchant, lumber merchant, grist and saw mill owner. A Captain in the Militia. Has been Local Superintendent of Schools, Reeve of North Plantagenet, and Warden of Prescott and Russell. Returned to Commons for Prescott at g.c. 1867; re-elected for same seat by acclamation at g.c. 1872, and again at g.e. 1874. First returned to Ontario Log. for same seat 1881 on death of Dr. Harkin, the sitting member. A Liberal, and a supporter of the Mowat Administration.—Plantagenet, Ont.

HARCOURT, RICHARD, M.A. (Monck.)

Third s. of Michael Harcourt, who was twice elected or Haldimand Co. in the old. Parlt. of Can. B. in Townhip of Seneca, Haldimand Co. 1849. Graduate and medallist of Toronto Univ. M., 1876, Augusta H., dau. of the late Jacob Young. Public School Inspector for Haldimand Co. for five years. First elected to the Leg. Assem. of Ont. Dec. 1878. Re-elected at last g.e. A Liberal.—Welland, Ont.

HARDY, Hon. ARTHUR STURGIS, Q.C. (South Brant.)

Descended on both sides from U.E. Loyalists. S. of Russell Hardy, Esq., merchant, Brantford, Ont. B. at Mount Pleasant, Ont., 14 Dec. 1837. Ed. at Rockwood Academy and at Co. Brant Grammar School. M., 19 Jan. 1870, Mary, dau. of Hon. Justice Morrison, of Toronto. Called to the Bar of Ont., Easter Term, 1865. Apptd. a Q.C. 1876. Is a Bencher of the Law Soc., Ont. First returned to Parlt., for present seat, April 1873, on resignation of sitting mem. Re-elected by acclammation at g.e. 1875. Apptd. Proyl. Secy. and Registrar, March 1877, and re-elected by acclammation. Again returned at last g.e. A Liberal.—Brantford; Toronto, Toronto Club.
