An Act to amend an Act intituled, "An Act respecting the Bureau of Agriculture and Agricultural Societies."

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Statute of this Province, Preamble. Chapter thirty-two of the Consolidated Statutes of Canada, intitaled, "An Act respecting the Bureau of Agriculture and Agricultural Secution", so far as the same affects Lower Canada; Therefore, Her 5 Mujesty, &c., enacts as follows:

There shall be, in each of the Judicial Districts of Lower Canada, District Agrian Agricultural Society, to be called The District Agricultural Society cultural Sofor the District of (naming it), and the powers of such Society small cieties. extend over and apply to the territorial limits of the Judicial District 10 for which it is constituted.
