

*ingūpa* speaks ill about him.

*ipaq* fibre, vein of wood etc. = LM.

*iparpâ* licks it = L.

*ipat* an addition to, or part of the ledge, for lamps etc.

*ipe* handle (of a tub etc.) = LM.

DRV. M. *ipiuterk* [*ipiutaq*] an isthme.

*ipeq*, with suffix *evqa*, dirt, filth = LCMWnsa.

*iperaq* (I) wick (for lamps) = M.

*iperaq* (II) a short harpoon line = LM.

*iperarpâ* (I) leaves hold of it = L.

*iperarpâ* (II) whips him (the dog) = LC.

*iperärpoq* wades, fords = LM.

*ipigpâ* applies a lever for moving it = LCM.

DRV. M. *ipotoark* [*ipugpoq*] rows with a boat-oar.

*ipigpoq* is sharp = LMWsa.

*ipivoq* is suffocated, drowns = LCM.

*ipo* shaft, handle = LCMWn.

*ipoq* it is (so or there) = LM.

— \* (M. *ibur*, plur. *ibut* iceberg).

*ipumerpoq* closes the mouth = L.

*isagpoq* stretches out his arms = LCMWn.

DRV. Wn. *isaro*, *isakuk* wing [*isaroq*].

*isavoq* moults, is gone to pieces = L.

*isavssoraq*, the same as *vjúkuq* (see hereafter).

*ise* skin for a tambourine = L.

*iseq* smoke = LCMWn. (*isök*).

*iserpoq* goes in = L. (*itterpok*) CMWs.

DRV. Ws. *ittychljuten* [*iserdlutit*] "come with me".

*isigaq* a toe, also: the middle part of the foot; plur. *isigkat* the foot = LCMWnsa.

*iso*, with suffix *isua* its end = LCMWn.

DRV. G. *isupâ* stretches it out; *isungaq* Stercorarius (skua, bird). — Ge. *isugdlog* short harpoon for boys. — Wn. *isungâ* skua.

*isog* + *isorpoq* is muddy, not clear = LM. (the stem still preserved in M. as *itchor* sediment).

*isugutaq* dew, moisture (Wn. *igesikhtuk* rain. — Ws. *iswich-tuk* rain).
