Sir,-

Referring to your memorandum of the 29th ultimo on a letter ~~from~~ Mr. Agent Keith, in which he asks that the money forwarded to the Department for lumber dues at Sturgeon Lake Reserve, be expended in the purchase of three waggons, one mower and one dozen hay-forks, and that the balance left after these articles are bought be laid out for axes, I beg to inform you that there has been a deduction of 10% for collection from the amount received, thus leaving only \$233.50 available for expenditure. This amount, however, can be laid out for the implements mentioned by Mr. Keith and whatever money is left over after the purchase of the waggons, mower and forks, be used in buying axes.
