I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letters of the 13th instant, and in reply I beg to confirm the following telegram sent you yesterday:- "You may engage Mr. Keely with engine and cement mixer and two assistants at total cost of twenty-one dollars a day. Work to be performed as expeditiously as possible. You may arrange for root cellar on north side of stable. Cement should be purchased from Messrs. Brown and Mitchell."
