Sale of timber: Kunstamis Reserve No. 2&2A

This timber was surrendered by the Indians of the Kwaw-waw-aineuk Band in 1935 and a condition of the surrender was that the Indians should be given 50% of the proceeds arising from the sale.

The timber was sold in 1935 to Mr.John Didricksen at a price of \$2.00 per M.f.b.m.

The cutting has been completed and the license cancelled.
