BY THE JUDGE ADVOCATE:

0-380 That is Station street?

A-380 Yes, sir.

Q-381 And then which way?

A-381 We had a trail that went right up here (indicating) and went in behind the billets and down through here (indicating).

Q-382 To which gate?

A-382 To the Engineers' entrance, sir.

BY THE DEFENDING OFFICER:

Q-383 You had used that gate many times before?

A-383 I always used it because my car was parked there.

2-384 You had parked your car there for two or three months?

A-384 Yes, sir.

Q-385 You have been in Camp for over a year?

A-385 Yes, sir.

Q-386 Is it the usual thing to have a little snack during the evening?

A-386 We always have.

Q-387 When you were stopped at the gate that night, what did you have in your possession?

A-387 I had a beg containing some apples and two cans of salmon. Some of the other boys had been bringing bread and butter; we all chipped in.

Q-388 What were you going to do with them?

A-388 Have some lunch in the billet.

Q-389 Where

A-389 In "B" Company.

Q-390 Who were?

A-390 McKinnon and Bradley.

Q-391 That is the usual thing to do in the evening?

A-391 Well, generally, yes.

Q-392 You have done it before and you thought nothing of it
