With Mrs. Stephens' superintendence and economical management of the establishment, the Committee have much pleasure in expresing their satisfaction; her duties as Matron and Instructress to the boys, have been ably fulfilled, and she has always carried out the directions of the attendant physician, with judgment and ability.

The third annual report of the Committee of Managers of the Boys' Home, Easton Road, London, England, has been received from the Honorary Secretary, George Bell Esq., and read with the greatest interest. The good and great work so successfully carried out in our Fatherland, cannot fail to encourage us to further and increased energy, to follow so noble an example.

The Committee feel convinced, that the establishment and maintenance of Homes for destitute boys, is the best and most promising mode of relieving our city of its juvenile destitution and crime, and they therefore earnestly entreat such pecuniary assistance, as may enable them to continue and extend their efforts for so desirable an object.
