

7. *Resolved*, That a sum not exceeding One thousand dollars be granted to Her Majesty, to defray expenses of Bridge over *Rideau* Canal, at the Narrows; for the financial year ending 30th June, 1867.

8. *Resolved*, That a sum not exceeding Six thousand dollars be granted to Her Majesty, towards new Gaol for the County of *Lincoln*, to be taken from the *U. C.* Building Fund; for the financial year ending 30th June, 1867.

9. *Resolved*, That a sum not exceeding Six thousand dollars be granted to Her Majesty, towards new Gaol for the County of *Frontenac*, to be taken from the *U. C.* Building Fund; for the financial year ending 30th June, 1867.

10. *Resolved*, That a sum not exceeding One thousand three hundred and fifty dollars be granted to Her Majesty, for additions and repairs to *Mc Gill* Normal School, to be taken from Normal School Building Fund; for the financial year ending 30th June, 1867.

11. *Resolved*, That a sum of Five thousand dollars be granted to Her Majesty, additional for Fisheries; for the financial year ending 30th June, 1867.

12. *Resolved*, That a sum not exceeding One hundred and thirty-four thousand and sixty dollars be granted to Her Majesty, for the purchase and maintenance of Gun Boats on the Lakes and River *St. Lawrence*; for the financial year ending 30th June, 1867.

13. *Resolved*, That a sum not exceeding Eight thousand dollars be granted to Her Majesty, for Barrack accommodation, for Militia; for the financial year ending 30th June, 1867.

14. *Resolved*, That a sum not exceeding Four thousand dollars be granted to Her Majesty, for Gratuity to Brigade Majors (Militia) for current year, \$200 each, when not otherwise employed; for the financial year ending 30th June, 1867.

15. *Resolved*, That a sum not exceeding Six thousand nine hundred and thirty-nine dollars and eighteen cents be granted to Her Majesty, for compensation for damages by Fenians in *Upper Canada*; for the financial year ending 30th June, 1867.

16. *Resolved*, That a sum not exceeding Fifteen thousand four hundred and sixty-three dollars and eighty-three cents be granted to Her Majesty for compensation for damages by Fenians in *Lower Canada*; for the financial year ending 30th June, 1867.

17. *Resolved*, That a sum not exceeding Four hundred and fourteen dollars be granted to Her Majesty, to pay for transport of Troops from *Bic* to *Quebec*, in 1862; for the financial year ending 30th June, 1867.

18. *Resolved*, That a sum not exceeding Four hundred dollars be granted to Her Majesty, for salary of agent of Attorney General, *Upper Canada*, at *Toronto*, (omitted in Estimates for Civil Government); for the financial year ending 30th June, 1867.

19. *Resolved*, That a sum not exceeding One hundred and ninety-one thousand nine hundred and one dollars and forty cents, be granted to Her Majesty, for arrears of indemnity to Townships in *Lower Canada*, payable one half 1st April, 1867, remainder 1st April, 1868; for the financial year ending 30th June, 1867.

20. *Resolved*, That a sum not exceeding Five hundred dollars be granted to Her Majesty, to procure a Bust of *Sir E. P. Taché*, for the Parliament House; for the financial year ending 30th June, 1867.

21. *Resolved*, That a sum not exceeding Two hundred and fifty thousand dollars be granted to Her Majesty, for the purchase of improved Fire Arms for the Militia Force; for the financial year ending 30th June, 1867.

22. *Resolved*, That a sum not exceeding One thousand and twenty-five dollars be granted to Her Majesty, to defray the expenses of billeting and transport of *Chicago* Volunteers, incurred by the City of *Toronto*; for the financial year ending 30th June, 1867.

23. *Resolved*, That a sum not exceeding Six thousand dollars be granted to Her Majesty, to defray the expenses of Printing of a General Index to Journals of Legislative Assembly, from eighteen hundred and fifty-two, to the end of present Parliament; for the financial year ending 30th June, 1867.

Ordered, That the said Resolutions be now read a second time.
