

## LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY,

Tuesday, 7th February, 1865.

*Ordered*, That one of the Masters in Chancery do go down to the Legislative Assembly, and acquaint that House that the Legislative Council doth give leave to the Honorable Mr. *Skead* to attend and give evidence before the Select Committee of that House appointed to take into consideration the contents of the Return to an Address of the 23rd of April, 1863, in relation to the Office of Supervisor of Cullers, if he thinks fit.

Then, on motion of the Honorable Mr. *Hamilton (Kingston)*, seconded by the Honorable Mr. *Ross*,
