ACADIA PRESIDENT **3.871 SETTLERS** ENTERED PROVINCE

Report of Department of Immigr tion and Colonization is Tabled

Three thousand eight hundred and seventy-six settlers came into Nova Sco-tia via ocean ports and from the United States during the twelve months ending September 30, 1924, according to the monthly returns of the Department of Immigration and Colonization included in the annual report of the Department of Industries and Immigration which was tabled in the local Legislature Tues-day.

The report points out that the depart-ment has dwelt directly with 1.228 per-sons, including families, and that this number brought in to the province capi-ral totalling \$327,659. Of this number 555 were skilled laborers and their de-pendents, while there were 298 farm settlers and 126 domestics. There were 271 male: farm settlers placed in the various counties of the province of whom 156 were from the British Isles and 115 were Scandinavians. In connection with the employment offices it is mentioned that a total of 42,253 applications had been received and that of this number 30,952 were re-applications.
