SENATOR SHERMAN'S VIEWS.
Important Interview in the London Times—No War With Spain—Cuba Not Wanted.

New York, March 15.—Mr. H. R. Chamberlain, in his special cable to The New York Sun, says: A good deal of interest is taken in London in a report of an interview between Secretary Sherman and Mr. George W. Lusk, which the latter carried to The London Times. It is represented that Mr. Sherman favors an arbitration which will continue the Olney policy in regard to Cuba and Spain. American citizens will be protected by the American flag, and those who are pursuing lawless occupations in a lawful way will be held entitled to the protection of the law and treaties, and in their behalf no efforts will be spared should they be seized on suspicion.

"There will be no war with Spain," the interview goes on. "We want none. We have no reason to believe that Spain wants war. If Spain would give me a quit-claim deed to the island of Cuba I would not have it. I have already stated my views against annexation, thinking that the United States is big enough already. He repelled the notion of desiring the annexation of Canada, peaceably or otherwise. 'It is for the interest of neither. I have already stated my views against annexation. My dream for the remote and permanent future of this North American continent is three great Republics—Canada, United States, and Mexico—but I would not take a step to alter this as they are. Who knows? Some hereafter must come by natural political evolution.'"

Items in Which People of the Dominion Are Concerned. Increase in the Duties on Farm and Dairy Products.
