Paris sends its children to school and supplies the poor ones with clothing, shoes, and food, as well as with free books, slates, stationery, and instruments. And it arranges that no child shall know which of the others are charity pupils. It sends poor children on summer outings. It builds houses and rents them at low rates, giving preference to the poorest and largest families. It taxes every theatre ticket ten per cent. for a public fund which furnishes every year fifteen thousand free beds in hospitals and as many more in asylums. This fund has also built a maternity hospital, where no questions are asked. It helps to bring up thousands of poor children. It furnishes free medicine for the sick poor. It collects a per diem from the employer for a workman who receives injury in the discharge of his duties. It spends ten


