ALDERMAN No 1—CHAMPLAIN WARD.

Alderman M. Foley, who represents Seat No. 1, Champlain Ward, was born in Quebec on November 27th, 1856.

He was first elected to the Council for St. Peter's Ward in 1886, which he continued to represent until 1894. In 1898, he was elected for his present seat in place of Hon. John Sharples who retired. He occupied this seat until 1904, when he was defeated, but was again re-elected in the recent elections.

Alderman Foley has carried on a successful business as merchant tailor since 1878.

In his younger days, he was quite an athlete and has always taken a lively interest in sporting matters. He is the possessor of no less than 7 gold and silver medals and 3 silver cups as a result of his prowess on the athlete field.
