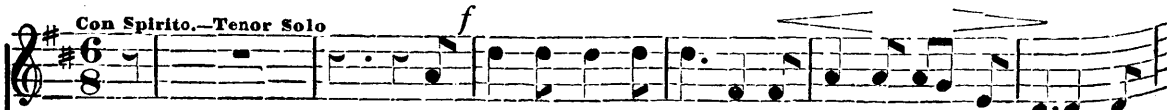


THE NOBLE LAW OF MAINE. (Solo Accompanied.)
