

REMARKS ON TORONTO METEOROLOGICAL REGISTER FOR MARCH, 1875.

The daily means, excepting those that relate to the wind, are derived from six observations daily, namely, at 6 A.M., 8 A.M., 2 P.M., 4 P.M., 10 P.M., and midnight. The means and results for the wind are from hourly observations.

Least windy day 20th; mean velocity 2.40 miles per hour.

Most windy hour noon; mean velocity 12.71 miles per hour.

Least windy hour 8 p.m.; mean velocity 7.07 miles per hour.

Solar haloes on 18th, 23rd, 29th and 30th; Lunar haloes on 13th and 18th.

Fog on 9th, 13th and 16th.

Lightning on 14th.

First Thunder Storm on 15th.

30th, Robins numerous—first seen on 12th; Crows on 15th; Song Sparrow, 30th.
