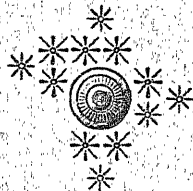


Nuclein Solution

FROM YEAST.

NUCLEIN is a non-poisonous germicide, found in various vegetable and animal cells, also in blood-serum, the bactericidal properties of which are due to this constituent. It increases the number of white blood-corpuscles and stimulates the activity of those organs whose function it is to protect the body against infectious diseases. It has been used with benefit in indolent ulcers, membranous tonsillitis, streptococcus diphtheria, and in INITIAL cases of tuberculosis.

Dose—20 to 60 minims hypodermatically.
